The Award for IQ is given for both innovation and quality in the process undertaken in a project (or projects) and the final product itself.

Whilst the Award is specifically intended for projects that display these characteristics and these principles, it is our intention not to be too formalistic with the way in which submissions for the Award can be made. We realise that projects need creativity, spirit and sound values, and we want applicants therefore to send us information and graphics that demonstrate why the project should be recognised. **As a guideline, the written submission should be between 1,000 and 2,000 words, with up to 10 photos or graphics.** All should be sent to us initially in one email (up to 10MB) please. We will ask for more information or higher resolution photos later if needed.

For this Award, projects shall be of high innovation and quality, in one or several of the following:

- Technological concept and design
- Materials, systems and equipment
- Methodology and process in design and implementation and/or production
- Function and use including sustainability

We are looking for projects where both the process used and the final product are of importance. Some of the aspects we are looking for are where new interpretations of proven IT tools or management techniques have been used, say for example within BIM. Or where life-cycle engineering and management tools have been successful. We also like to reward outstanding new technologies, construction techniques, and design features. The criteria will also distinguish and reward effort and risk-taking in developing construction project management and the construction industry.

Submissions should include the title of the project or initiative; the names, roles and organisational participants, both client, consultant and project manager; the value the project (if known); start and end dates; and any relevant websites. **Submissions should be emailed to info@icpma.net and icpmamembers@gmail.com.**

The Judges decision is final. The Award is made by ICPMA in association with DVP and both organisations would like to ensure that all applicants and submissions can be included in any yearbook or other publication produced by ICPMA or DVP and that the winners will be included on their websites and social media. Applicants should make note on any submission made if any part of that submission or any other information given is confidential in nature and cannot be so used.
